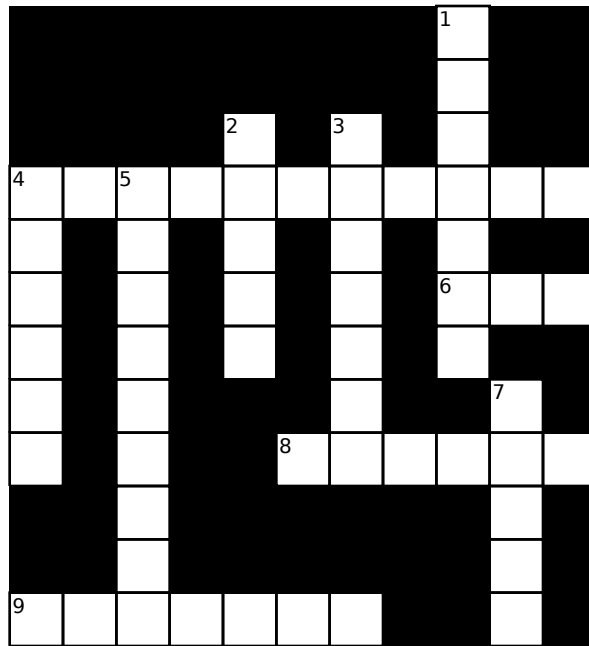


What is the Gospel?
